研究成果の 概要  Academic Achievement	<p>First I would like to again thank Doshisha University for its generous financial support for ongoing research projects. I am deeply aware of what a privilege this is.</p> <p>For the first six months of the academic year I was engaged in reading through appropriate secondary literature, much of it purchased with the help of the research funding. I also gave a presentation to a research study group on campus, headed by Professor Keiko Ikeda, as well as two presentations for American undergraduates in a study abroad program. All of these presentations were based on research related to Nijima Jo, and his encounters with the United States.</p> <p>For the past six months I have been on academic leave as a researcher, working to complete a significant portion of my book manuscript. During that time I have read a significant number of secondary books, purchased through the research grant, and have also taken several research trips to the United States for archival work. These included Andover Seminary, the Boston Public Library, the Congregational Library (Boston) (all in the summer of 2010) and to Amherst College University Archives (February 2011). These have provided the research basis for now three completed chapters of the book manuscript.</p> <p>In addition, I have an essay published in a new edited collection from the University of California Press, titled <i>Manners and Mischief: Gender, Power and Etiquette in Japan</i> (2011).</p> <p>Finally, I have been able to now complete three of the chapters and am significantly advanced on a fourth. I am therefore continually grateful for the financial support.</p>
